



Clear Creek Family Mission Trip

- Location:** Clear Creek Baptist Bible College (300 Clear Creek Rd, Pineville, KY 40977)
- Dates:** September 30 – October 4, 2018 (leave from Severns Valley at 2:00 pm Sunday and leave Clear Creek after lunch on Thursday)
- Arrive in the Pineville area about 5:30 pm and eat dinner (your cost)
- Transportation:** Church bus and trailer
- Lodging:** Kelly Hall on Clear Creek Campus (possibly another dorm)—provided free! You will need to bring linens, towels, blankets, and pillows, as well as all toiletries. All rooms have 2 twin beds—dorm style. Showers and bathrooms are shared on the hallways. Males will be on one floor and females on another floor.
- Meals:** Clear Creek provides meals to their workgroups. Meals are served in the Dining Hall at 7:00 am, 12:00 noon, and 5:00 pm Monday thru Thursday.
- Work/Service:** Projected needs are light carpentry, replace carpet with tile floor, painting family housing, staining decks, pressure washing, and brush clean-up. Depending on skills, there could be other projects. Please let us know your skills and any tools you could take as soon as possible. (There are no needs at present for cleaning/organizing, etc)
- Cost:** \$60 per person
- Preparation:** Everyone would need to attend some meetings as we prepare to be a team. First meeting set for August 19th at 4:00 pm.

Church Family Time:

- Group worship time—room provided (daily devotions together)
- Access to the Family Life Center (indoor pool, gym, volleyball, etc—open til 9:00 pm)
- Wednesday afternoon time to sight-see

There is the Pine Mountain State Park approximately 3 miles up the mountain from us. There are hiking trails and a place to go zip-lining. There is also the Cumberland Gap National Historical Park about 12 miles from us. It contains a small museum, history of Daniel Boone, and some scenic areas that overlook Kentucky, Tennessee and Virginia. There are also some places to hike on campus.
